INGEDE Working Group “Recovered Paper Quality” meets in Ortman

The latest meeting of the working group “Recovered Paper Quality” started with a visit of the facilities of Bunzl & Biach in Vienna on Nov 28, 2011. This SCA owned company provides a major part of secondary fibre material for the two Austrian SCA mills. The visited site is specialized on grades needed at the Ortman mill for the production of hygiene papers. Right after that the group travelled to the Ortman mill to get an impression on a highly efficient production line of toilet paper, napkins and some other end consumer hygiene products. The next day was reserved for intensive discussions about

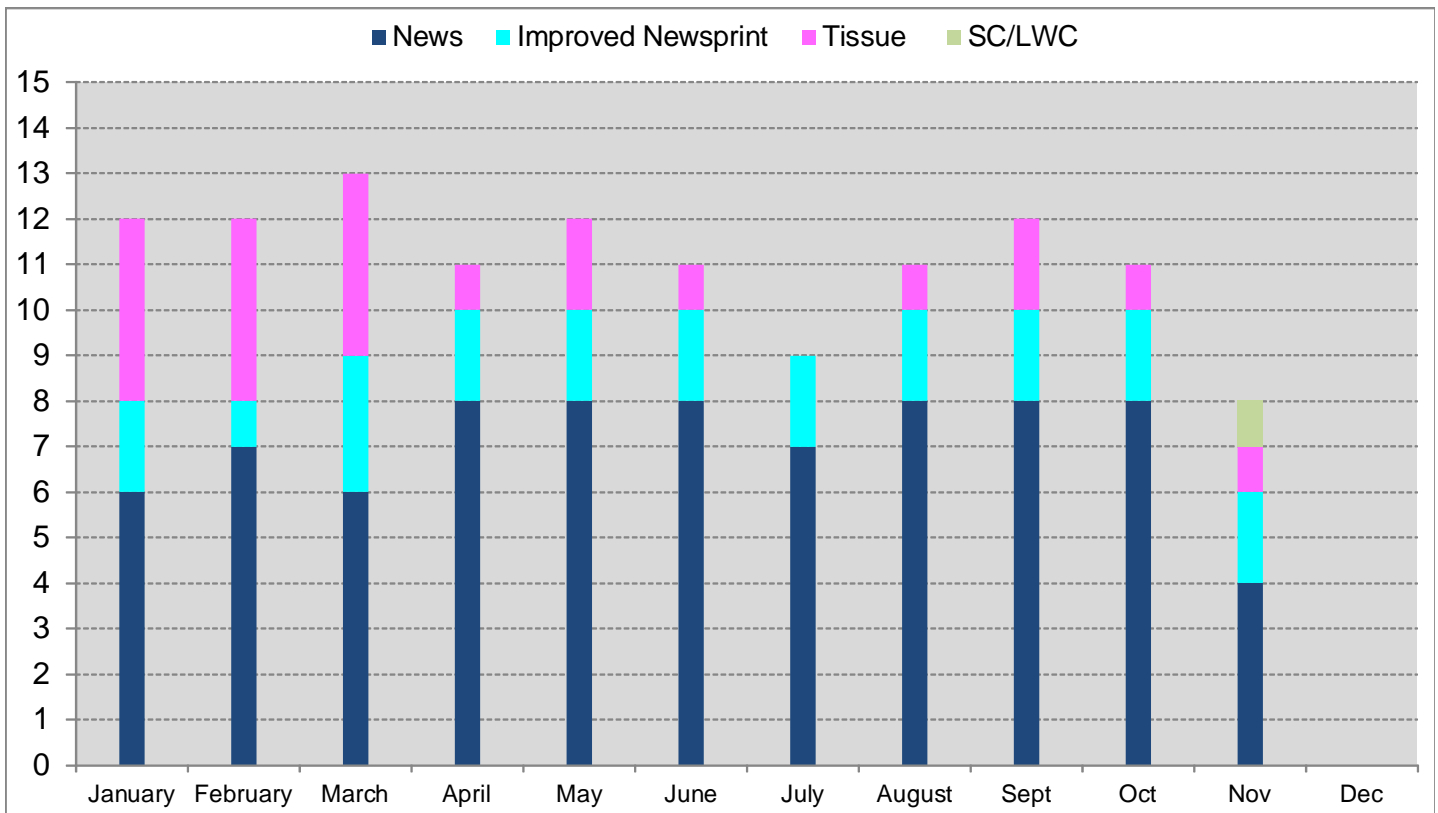
latest experience on quality issues. Andreas Faul gave an overview of the results of the annual Recovered Paper Database. Luckily we had a good response rate again. Due to the fact that there are several member mills using higher grades, the evaluation can be done in two categories. Further on some adaption in the questionnaire has to be made which was agreed in the meeting. Another topic was the definition of the main grades for deinking in graphic paper and hygiene paper production. A listing of wanted and unwanted papers will support discussions with other associations

about our needs. Of course this will be done according to the description in the draft for the new EN 643 and other regulations. The Darmstadt university starts two projects, one is dealing with the effects of the composition of Deinking (1.11) and the other with the migration of mineral oil. The working group will follow up the investigations, 3 members of the working group are members of the project committee, and we will deeply discuss the findings in the next meetings. To improve the networking within INGEDE members a first attempt was undertaken to check the possibilities and the benefit of the professional Internet network LINKEDIN (www.linkedin.com). It is seen by the working group as a useful tool for common issues. Prerequisite is to install a closed group for INGEDE members. The next meeting will take place in Perlen, CH on April 17-18, 2012. It will be combined with the working group DIP Quality Management, which will have their meeting on the following day. *Manfred Geistbeck*
